ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF WITHDRAWAL

Dear Ms. Davis:

By letter dated June 10, 2015, you submitted an application for approval of a new Quality Assurance Program under Title 10, *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 71. You requested approval of this program to support shipping radioactive material under the 10 CFR Part 71 general license provisions. Staff performed an acceptance review of your application to determine if the application contains sufficient information in scope and depth to allow the staff to complete the detailed review.

By letter dated June 30, 2015, you requested to withdraw the application from NRC review. The NRC acknowledges your request to withdraw the application. NRC staff activities on the review have ceased.

The NRC staff notes that its review to date has identified that your application did not provide information on all eighteen quality assurance criteria described in 10 CFR Part 71 Subpart H in sufficient detail to enable the staff to complete a detailed review. Therefore, if you decide to re-submit the request, it must include a discussion of which Subpart H requirements apply and how you will implement the applicable quality criteria to the quality related activities of your specific program.
