Dear Sir:

My letter of April 18, 1983 submitted a proposed revision to the Oconee Nuclear Station Technical Specifications. The submittal requested a postponement of certain surveillance requirements to be performed during Unit 1's upcoming refueling outage. Review of the justification supporting the proposal, submitted as Attachment 2 of the April 18 letter, has identified typographical errors and a need to update portions of the text so that the bases for requesting relief are more accurately reflected.

The attached table (Attachment 2) indicated the pages and sections on those pages requiring updating. For a particular section, substitute the text found in the table for the original text submitted in the April 18 letter.

Typographical errors have been identified on pages A-1, C-2, and W-1. The corrected copies of these pages for substitution with the original pages are also attached.

In addition, pages V-1, V-2 should be deleted from the text. The control rod drive relative position indicator amplifier calibration does not require an extension of its surveillance frequency because its due date is September 25, 1983.

Further, discussions with your Staff concerning this proposal have indicated that the proposed Technical Specification changes, provided in Attachment 1 of my April 18 letter, need to be revised in order that individual test/calibrations/inspections are identified as those requiring relief as oppose to a general waiver. Therefore, please delete the entire Attachment 1 of my April 18 letter and substitute Attachment 1 of this letter.


