
The purpose of this letter is to provide the status of modifications associated with seismic qualification of the Emergency Feedwater system at Oconee Nuclear Station.

In a letter dated January 14, 1987, the NRC issued a Safety Evaluation Report (SER) on seismic qualification of the Emergency Feedwater system (EFW) for Oconee. The SER stated that the criteria for Generic Letter 81-14 and requirements of General Design Criteria 2 and 34 have been met and Multiplant Action Item C-14 is considered to be completed for Oconee. The SER also stated that Duke Power had committed to correct the deficiencies identified in the seismic qualification of the EFW system in accordance with the licensing design basis. In a letter dated March 20, 1987, Duke Power provided a schedule for completing the required modifications to resolve the deficiencies. The modifications were to be completed for all three units by March 6, 1990.

In accordance with the commitments provided in the March 20, 1987 letter, Duke Power has completed the modifications that were discussed in the SER.
