You are invited to attend the "Crying Earth Rise Up!" screening and informative panel discussion concerning the insitu leach uranium mining process on Thursday, August 13, at 5:30 p.m. in the Crawford Community Building at 1005 First St. This is to inform the public of the Cameco renewal and expansion plans for the Crow Butte Uranium Mine. Feel free to invite anyone who might be interested.

The United States Atomic Licensing Board of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission is holding a hearing concerning the renewal license of Crow Butte operations daily to address 9 contentions regarding the renewal of Cameco Crow Butte Resources operating license during the week of August 24-28, 2015 beginning at 9 a.m. and ending at 6 p.m. at the Community Building. Cameco intends to expand south toward Marsland, near the Niobrara River. Please plan to come to be informed on this important issue. Lives are at stake concerning contamination and restoration of water in White River and its tributaries. Help us protect our water.

I lived within a mile of the Crow Butte Mine operation until last year. I have watched mining progress through the years from the beginning. The last several years I feel a growing concern for my health and my friends working in the mine. Too many are fighting cancer. My late husband said he saw neighbors who worked in the Wyoming open pit mines all succumb to cancer within 20 years. It isn't worth the price. Ask, "How many deceased/current employees have cancer?"
