**SUBJECT: ACKNOWLEDGEMENT LETTER TO REDISTRIBUTE AND TRANSFER
GENERALLY LICENSED DEVICES WITHIN THE UNITED STATES AIR FORCE**

This letter serves as an acknowledgment of your letters dated September 10, 2012, and December 23, 2013, requesting that your license be amended to allow the redistribution of Generally Licensed Devices (GLDs) within the United States Air Force (USAF) and from the USAF and other Department of the Defense (DOD) entities, states, and local entities such as universities, fire departments, and police departments. The Division of Material Safety, State, Tribal, and Rulemaking Programs (MSTR) determined that you may redistribute and transfer GLDs within the USAF, if it is performed in accordance with the requirements on 10 CFR 31.5, specifically per the provisions of 10 CFR 31.5(c)(9), provided the device remains in use at the same location.

If you wish to transfer the GLDs to other DOD or state or local entities, you must take one of the following actions: (1) submit an application for a license amendment to your MML, in accordance with the requirements of the 10 CFR 32.51, to allow you to distribute the GLDs under a specific GLD distribution license, or (2) transfer the GLDs to a licensee that holds a specific GLD distribution license, under which this licensee would distribute the GLDs to other DOD entities and state and local entities.

Please note that you will also need to manage, inventory, and track the transfer of any GLDs and provide the NRC with the quarterly transfer reports in accordance with 10 CFR 32.52(a) and (b) and maintain records in accordance with 10 CFR 32.52(c).
