Our facility, Community Hospital, is requesting an addition of a nuclear medicine suite for the second floor of the Medical Office Building located at 801 MacArthur Boulevard in Munster, IN. We have already submitted the application with all the relevant drawings and documents. 
The site will have two cardiac nuclear medicine cameras and three rooms with treadmills for cardiac stress studies. Procedures to be performed are Myocardial stress/Rest studies. The isotope utilized will be Tc-99. There will be no PET studies involved.

The above procedures will need authorized use for

- Any uptake, dilution and excretion study permitted by 10 CFR 35.100 and
- Any imaging and localization study permitted by 10 CFR 35.200
