Enclosed is Amendment No. 11 to your NRC Material License No. 21-21045-01 in accordance with your letter dated June 2, 2015. Changes made to your license are printed in **bold font**.

In addition to the above referenced amendment, please note our updated response to your letter received January 7, 2013. In that letter, your company submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) a Request for Consent to a direct License Transfer of NRC Materials License No. 21-21045-01. Based on the information provided, we understand that – as a result of the sale of stock and assets from Kinnco, Inc. to Kinnco Services LLC – control of Kinnco, Inc. was directly transferred to Kinnco Services LLC on June 1, 2014. We further understand that this transfer has resulted in a change to the licensed name – now Kinnco Services LLC – for the above referenced license. However, we also understand that the transaction has resulted in no other changes to the licensed materials, persons using the licensed material, location of use of licensed material, or persons responsible for the licensee's radiation safety program.


Based on the understanding outlined above, and as more fully detailed in the enclosed NRC Safety Evaluation Report (SER), we have no objection to the described transfer. The SER documents the NRC staff's review of the request. Further, we have noted that the transaction was effective and complete on June 1, 2014, as noted in your July 28, 2015 letter.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.

The NRC's Safety Culture Policy Statement became effective in June 2011. While a policy statement and not a regulation, it sets forth the agency's *expectations* for individuals and organizations to establish and maintain a positive safety culture.
