Subject: Financial Assurance and Ra-226 sources

Discussion:

Discussed the status of the amendment to the Standby Trust Agreement and the radium 226 sources. We are in receipt of their letter dated December 5, 2014 in which they commit to leak testing the remaining Ra-226 sources to demonstrate that they remain sealed and that they will amend the Financial Assurance Agreement (FAA) if they plan to possess unsealed radioactive sources with half-lives greater than 120 days at any time in the future.

Discussed changing the wording in Condition 10 of License No. 06-00819-03 which currently authorizes material to be used at 20 York St., New Haven (the Main Campus); 111 Goose Lane, Guilford; 40 Temple St., New Haven; 1450 Chapel St., New Haven; 2 Devine St., Suite 1, North Haven; 1591 Boston Post Rd., Guilford; and 79 Wawecus St., Norwich. As this allows materials with a half-life of greater than 120 days this affects their need to have a Decommissioning Funding Plan. I informed him that they could limit the use at the locations other than the Main Campus (20 York St., New Haven) to the material listed in Condition 6.A. which is any byproduct material with atomic numbers 1 through 83 and half-life less than 120 days.

Mr. Bohan agreed to request a change to their license to allow use of only the material listed in Condition 6.A. at the following locations: 111 Goose Lane, Guilford; 40 Temple St., New Haven; 1450 Chapel St., New Haven; 2 Devine St., Suite 1, North Haven; 1591 Boston Post Rd., Guilford; and 79 Wawecus St., Norwich.

Action Required: Licensee to submit request to amend license.
