Enclosed is the initial response to your letter of July 9, 2015, requesting documents and information regarding the information that was used and analyzed in creating the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) proposed rule that would amend 40 C.F.R. Part 192 to include new health and environmental protection standards for uranium *in-situ* recovery facilities. The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has identified additional responsive documents that were prepared by, or involve the equities of, other federal agencies. The NRC is currently coordinating with those agencies and will communicate with you further about these additional documents.

For your awareness, also enclosed is a recent letter that NRC's General Counsel sent EPA's General Counsel following the publication of the proposed EPA rule. The NRC looks forward to working with EPA to resolve these matters.
