Report of UFSAR Chapter 14 Changes to Initial Test Program  
In Accordance with License Condition 2.D.(7)(a)

Ladies and Gentlemen:

In accordance with license condition 2.D.(7)(a) of the Vogtle Electric Generating Plant (VEGP) Units 3 and 4 Combined Licenses, Numbers NPF-91 and NPF-92, respectively, Southern Nuclear Operating Company (SNC) is required to report, within 30 days, a change made to the Initial Test Program described in Final Safety Analysis Report Section 14, in accordance with 10 CFR 50.59(d).

On August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2015, SNC approved Licensing Document Change Request (LDCR) 2015-088, changing the Initial Test Program described in the VEGP Units 3&4 Updated Final Safety Analysis Report (UFSAR), Subsection 14.2, Specific Information to be Included in Standard Safety Analysis Reports, and Subsection 14.4, Combined License Applicant Responsibilities. No changes were made to test abstracts, but several changes were made to Initial Test Program administrative descriptions to clarify roles and responsibilities, training requirements, and oversight activities.

This departure from Tier 2 information in the UFSAR (which includes the plant-specific DCD) was evaluated in accordance with 10 CFR 52 Appendix D Section VIII, and it was determined that these changes did not involve changes to Tier 1 information, Tier 2\* information, or the Technical Specifications. The evaluation also determined that prior NRC approval for this departure was not required.
