I am Alia Lakota Brennan. I have lived in Dawes county all my life. I was born in Crawford Ne., but live in Chadron Ne. now. I am a college student at Chadron State College. I am also a member of the Oglala Sioux Tribe.

The Oglala Sioux Tribe, my tribe, should have been formally consulted, nation to nation, in the permit process for this uranium mine.

Water is a finite resource. I believe that Crow Butte resources ISL mine has contaminated our ground water and aquifer in this area. There is scientific research that suggests this. CB ISL mine currently has around 75 violations. Dangerously risky work, mechanical and industrial practices are currently being used and have been used! I am 20 years old. My future is at stake!! Clean water is necessary for public health. Our lives depend on it. Please allow the new scientific research to be considered. This uranium mine must have it's license revoked and the expansion must be stopped!!
