Dear Mr. Lewandowski:

It has come to our attention that Amendment No. 48 to your NRC Material License No. 22-00057-61, issued on May 26, 2015, contained two errors.

What was intended to be numbered Condition No. 15 was accidentally included in Condition No. 14.

Enclosed is a corrected copy that shows Condition No. 15 correctly. The subsequent Conditions have been renumbered as a result.

In addition, I took this opportunity to remove the language "with attachments" from the letters contained in Condition No. 20.B. (or, Condition No. 19.B. on the uncorrected version of Amendment 48).

The language in this condition already states "including any enclosures" so the now-removed language could have created redundancy. The revised language should be clearer.

We apologize for these errors and for any inconvenience they may have caused you.
