To Whom It May Concern,

I am an employee of one of the key suppliers to Crow Butte / Cameco Resources. I have worked with these companies and their competitors for over 25 years. I have seen the practices these companies work by and they have the environment at the top of their priority list. We have provided drilling fluid schools to all of the In Situ mine in Nebraska and Wyoming. They all use nothing but the highest quality products in their exploration, drilling and processing procedures. The combination of the drilling fluids, practices and regulations these companies adhere to are second to none. I deal with several of the employees at Crow Butte and the surrounding community. In the years I have been dealing with this people I have never known of any ground water contamination or well excursion to take place. If the renewal of Crow Buttes license should not go through it would have a significant negative on the livelihood of the town of Crawford and surrounding ranchers. The lack of mining activity at Crow Butte the last two years has had a negative impact on our small family owned business and several others that supply various products to the facility. In closing I would ask that you would allow the license to go through if on nothing else but the fact there is no scientific or other proven evidence that groundwater contamination or any other form of environment negligence has occurred.
