The letter requests voluntary submittal of occupational radiation exposure data for certain employees for whom termination reports were not required prior to the implementation of new 10CFR20. The information will be used to update the Radiation Exposure Information Reporting System (REIRS) database, which is the basis for Nureg-0713, Occupational Radiation Exposure at Commercial Nuclear Power Reactors and Other Facilities. Duke Power Company has reviewed your request for information and has determined it will be mutually beneficial for us to comply. Unit 2, NPF 52


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Due to the magnitude of information you have requested, and the number of sites we must report for, it will take more than the requested 180 days to complete. We have estimated it will take approximately 18 months to fully complete your request.
