
The purpose of this letter is to request authorization to initiate feed inlet and commence operation of Assay 5 Cascade 10. Louisiana Energy Services, LLC dba URENCO USA (UUSA) has successfully performed procedure OP-3-0450-03, IROFSC23 Surveillance Procedure, Revision 10 and has demonstrated that Cascade 5.10 meets the requirements of IROFSC23.

The data was reviewed and all acceptance criteria have been met. The verification results of the surveillance have been documented in accordance with UUSA Procedure EG-3-2100-05, Commercial Grade Dedication Process. The Commercial Grade Dedication Form 3, Enclosure 1, is enclosed for NRC Staff review.

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
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
