Enclosed is an application, dated August 11, 2015, received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), from Leidos, Inc. requesting amendment No. 05 to its existing license, XB1310/04. The license presently authorizes the export of 60 curies of cobalt-60 and 25 microcuries of cesium-137, both contained in sealed sources, to Iraq for non-intrusive inspection of cargo/vehicles and equipment operability verification at multiple sites along border and facility entrances.

The purpose of the amendment is to: 1) change the ultimate consignee from the Iraq Ministry of Interior to the Government of Iraq, and 2) extend the date of expiration from December 31, 2015 to December 31, 2020.

Before taking action on this amendment request, we would appreciate your views, in accordance with established procedures and from the overall perspective of the Executive Branch, as to whether the requested export meets the applicable criteria in the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended.
