My reason of concern regarding the Fermi 2 Spent Fuel Pool unloading schedule stems from this 1999 Holtec Report M1-992154, Revision 6.

While Holtec seems confident that replacement water is more than abundant, nuclear engineers with whom I consult inform me that the humidity would be so extreme that electrical equipment would begin to fail under these extreme conditions. The overloaded Spent Fuel Pool at Fermi 2 is of grave concern, and the suggested mitigation is suspect. I draw your attention to the Fermi 2 Spent Fuel Pool with hopes of preventing a catastrophic failure.
