
Dear Sir:

By letter dated August 28, 1986 Duke Power Company (Duke) provided a response to Staff concerns regarding Inservice Inspection (ISI) at Oconee Nuclear Station during the second ten year inspection interval. Request 1(a) referred to 46 hydrotests for which relief from ASME Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code Section XI requirements during the first ten year inspection interval.

Per the response to Item 1(a), Duke has determined that references 8, 9, 12, and 16 involved requests for relief from hydrotests required after maintenance or modification. As such, relief will not be required for these items during the second ten year interval.

References 14, 23, 24, 26, 29, and 31 involve requests for relief that may be applicable to the second ten year interval, however, these hydrotests are not required to be completed until the end of the second interval. Duke will not be submitting requests for relief for references 14, 23, 24, 26, 29, and 31 at this time. Requests for relief, if necessary, will be submitted prior to the end of the second ten year interval.
