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

This letter is written to provide additional information to the July 28, 1987 letter from Duke Power to the NRC concerning modifications to the Confirmatory Order for Oconee Nuclear Station. Analyses have been performed for all of the design basis accidents identified in the FSAR for each unit and their attending single active failures. This review confirmed that with assumed lake water temperatures up to 85°F and appropriate reductions in power levels, there will be no adverse impact on the public health and safety beyond that identified in the FSAR.

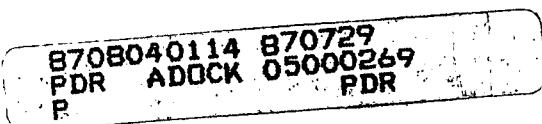
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
