Steve,

We are in the final stages of issuing the revised license for the ISFF ISFSI. As part of the staff's review of the application, the staff proposed to remove Condition No. 13 of Materials License SNM-2512. We recommended removing this condition because it would have prevented the licensee from making changes to the Quality Assurance Program without prior NRC approval, which is allowed under NRC regulations in Part 72, and that you sought in your request to add Section 5.5.6 of the Technical Specifications. The current wording of the condition references a specific revision of the QA program and its date of issue, and, therefore, would need NRC approval to change.

During review by the NRC's legal counsel, they (NRC counsel) mentioned that it would be preferable that we seek your consent and agreement to any changes in the license conditions that were not requested as part of the application, and have asked us to confirm with you that you want the license condition removed from the license.

Accordingly, I am seeking your consent and agreement for us to issue the amended license with the existing Condition No. 13 removed. I can use your response to this email as a record of the decision and enter it into the docket as such.
