Patrick,

We've opened a financial assurance amendment action for LN SMB-141 because your decommissioning funding plan (DFP) requires an update to be submitted.

10 CFR 40.36(d) requires that, at the time of license renewal and at intervals not to exceed three years, the DFP must be resubmitted with adjustments as necessary to account for changes in costs and the extent of contamination. Your currently approved DFP was submitted with a letter dated May 31, 2011 and amended June 20, 2011, therefore your DFP must be re-submitted. The DFP must update the information submitted with the original or prior approved DFP, and must specifically consider the effect of the following events on decommissioning costs: (1) spills of radioactive material producing additional residual radioactivity in onsite subsurface material; (2) waste inventory increasing above the amount previously estimated; (3) waste disposal costs increasing above the amount previously estimated; (4) facility modifications; (5) changes in authorized possession limits; (6) actual remediation costs that exceed the previous cost estimate; (7) onsite disposal; and (8) use of a settling pond.

If the amount of financial assurance will be adjusted downward, this cannot be done until the updated DFP is approved by NRC. If the amount of financial assurance increases, then you will also have to submit a revised Certificate of Financial Assurance (CFA) to reflect the new amount.
