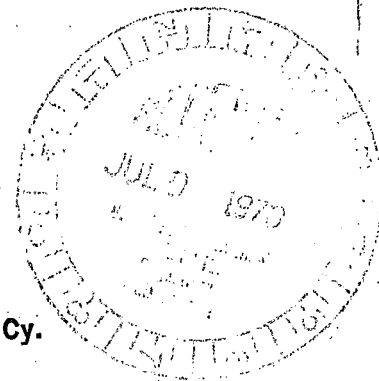
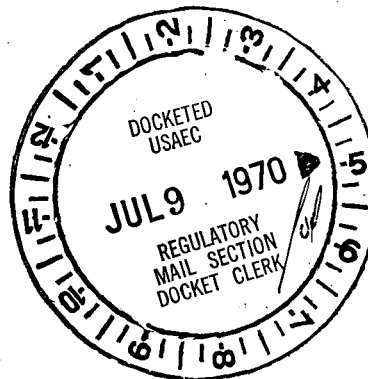

Dear Dr. Morris:

Duke Power Company is filing herewith Amendment No. 14 to its Application for Licenses for the Oconee Nuclear Station, which is under construction pursuant to provisional construction permits CPPR-33, -34, and -35 issued by the Commission on November 6, 1967. This filing includes three (3) signed original copies of the Amendment with attachments and seventy (70) copies of Duke Power Company Proprietary Report answering DRL Questions 3.1.4 and 4.3 attached to Dr. Peter A. Morris's letter of February 13, 1970 and Question 14.3.5 attached to his March 3, 1970 letter.


