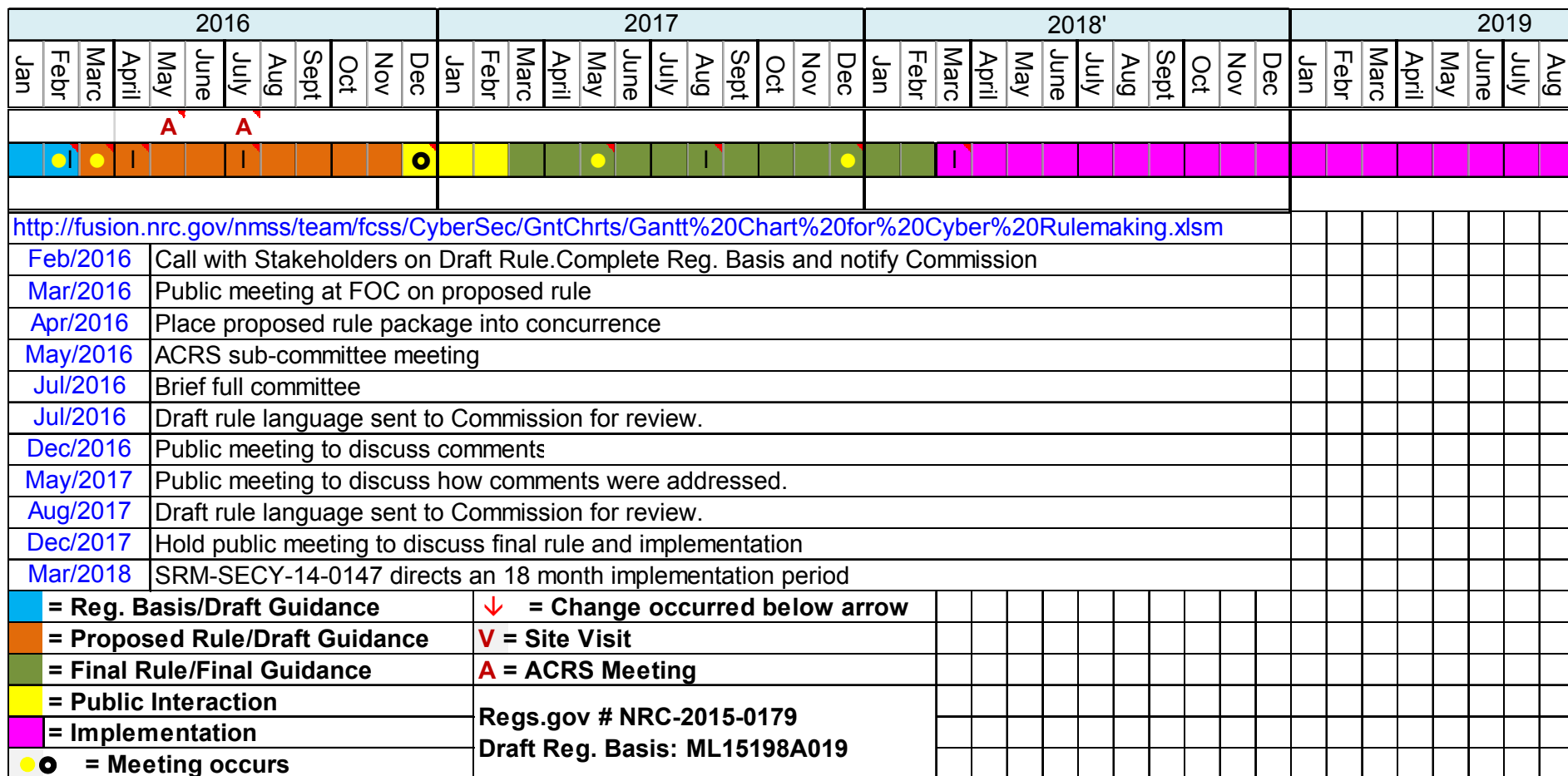
The purpose of this meeting is to discuss the cyber security proposed rulemaking for fuel cycle facilities.
