**SUBJECT: U.S. NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION, LICENSE AMENDMENT NO. 4,
MATERIALS LICENSE SUA-1580, ADMINISTRATIVE AMENDMENT CHANGING
LICENSEE ADDRESS, HYDRO RESOURCES, INC., CROWNPOINT URANIUM
PROJECT, (TAC NO. J00799)**

Dear Mr. Henderson:

By letter dated November 27, 2015, Uranium Resources, Inc., (URI) on behalf of its wholly-owned subsidiary Hydro Resources, Inc. (HRI), and Laramide Resources Ltd. (Laramide), submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) an application requesting approval for an indirect change of control of the Crownpoint Uranium Project, Materials License SUA-1580, from URI to Laramide. The application was made publicly available in the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) and can be found at Accession No. ML15334A483. The NRC completed its review and approved the transaction in a letter, accompanying Safety Evaluation Report (SER), and draft license dated March 11, 2016 (Accession Package No. ML16029A395).

On January 31, 2017, URI notified the NRC that the transaction was completed. The transaction resulted in control of the Crownpoint Uranium Project Materials License SUA-1580 being transferred from URI to Laramide, although the licensee, HRI, remains the same. As discussed in the March 11, 2016, approval letter, accompanying SER, and draft license, the NRC staff is administratively amending Materials License SUA-1580 to change the address for HRI and the mailing address for NRC correspondence. Enclosure 1 contains Material License SUA-1580, Amendment No. 4.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Agency Rules of Practice and Procedure," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records component of NRC's ADAMS.
