Dear Ms. Rivera:

FEMA indicated a need to review the findings in the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Interim Findings Report (IFR) dated February 17, 2010, for the Levy Nuclear Plant (LNP) Units 1 and 2 Combined License (COL). FEMA felt that the decommissioning of Crystal River Unit 3 and the potential for its impact on the original findings regarding adequacy of off-site capabilities necessitated this review.

FEMA Region IV has completed a review of the latest revision of the application provided by your office. They determined that the State of Florida and affected local governments have established an adequate planning framework for the proposed Levy Nuclear Station. The commitment to re-engage in an active emergency planning program by the State of Florida, and the counties of Marion, Levy and Citrus, provide the necessary assurances that the protection of the health and safety of off-site populations is maintained. FEMA Region IV will continue to work with the State of Florida and affected county governments to ensure the capability to protect the health and safety of the public from a radiological emergency at the proposed Levy Nuclear Station. FEMA Headquarters concurs with the Region's findings.
