Mr. Simpson,

This is in reference to your letter dated September 24, 2015, requesting for amendment to Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 10-06772-01, Docket No. 03004001. In order to continue our review and in addition to the January 13 electronic mail request for additional information, we need the following additional information:

Pb-210 is listed as a radionuclide historically stored in the Radioactive Waste Room #1 at the Chamblee Building I. An analysis of Pb-210 was not provided in the Decommissioning Plan for the development of DCGLs. Please justify excluding Pb-210 from consideration as a radionuclide of concern or provide the RESRAD-BUILD analysis of Pb-210.

Please also update the decommissioning plan to reflect the revised approach for Pb-210, as necessary.
