On March 10, 2016, the NRC staff conducted a public meeting (Reference 1) with representatives from Duke Energy to support the staff's safety reviews of the AP1000 Combined License (COL) applications. Specifically, the meeting addressed NRC staff proposed generic AP1000 license conditions, which can be found in the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System under Accession Number ML16062A021. These license conditions are expected to be identical for LNP Units 1 and 2 and WLS Units 1 and 2. Duke Energy Florida, LLC originally submitted the LNP Units 1 and 2 COL application (COLA) by Progress Energy Florida, Inc. on July 28, 2008. Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC originally submitted the WLS Units 1 and 2 COLA on December 12, 2007. Both the LNP and WLS COLAs incorporate by reference Appendix D to 10 CFR Part 52 based on the Westinghouse Electric Company AP1000 Design Control Document Revision 19.

Duke Energy provided feedback on the proposed license conditions during the March 10 meeting. The staff responded to comments and suggested changes as appropriate. Duke Energy concurs with the staff responses and changes outlined in an NRC memorandum dated March 15, 2016 (Reference 2).
