Modified Reactor Safeguards Information—Not for Public Release

Sir or Madam:

On December 4, 2014, the NIST Center for Neutron Research (NCNR) modified the TR-5 test reactor (NBSR) Physical Security Plan as permitted by 10 CFR 50.54(p)(2). NCNR management does not consider this change to the NBSR Physical Security Plan to be a reduction in the safeguard effectiveness of the plan. However, in order to obtain NRC concurrence on this, we request a license amendment reflecting this change to the NBSR Physical Security Plan. A description of change, as stated in a letter to the NRC on December 30, 2014, is repeated below in the Attachment. In addition, attached is a full version of our latest Physical Security Plan dated 2008.
