In order to continue the review of your application for your NRC license to use radioactive materials, we need additional information. If you have any questions, please contact me (610-337-5089).

In your application you have requested that the license and radioactive material formerly held by Eastern Associated Coal, LLC, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Patriot Coal Corporation be transferred to ERP Federal Mining Complex, LLC. During a phone conversation on March 28, 2016, you indicated that ERP Federal Mining Complex, LLC. is a subsidiary of the Virginia Conservation Legacy Fund (VCLF). Please provide a more extensive description of the bankruptcy transactions between Patriot Coal Corporation and VCLF including dates and documentation. In addition, please describe the business relationship between VCLF and ERP Federal Mining Complex, LLC.
2. During the telephone conversation on March 28, 2016, you indicated that you have been granted power-of-attorney for ERP Federal Mining Complex, LLC for regulatory matters. Please submit documentation confirming your authorization.

Please be sure to include the Control No. 590399 on your response. We would appreciate a response within 10 days in order to expedite the review of the license application.
