Dear U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission personnel:

I am writing about the cultural issues that affect Strata Energy Inc.'s application to expand the Ross in situ uranium recovery facility in Crook County, Wyoming.

I understand that there are 24 cultural properties recorded in the study area, and 23 are prehistoric sites and one is a historic homestead site. Experts note that 15 prehistoric sites are eligible for the National Register of Historic Places, because they are likely to yield information about the occupations of the headwaters of the Little Missouri River. In addition, a very large prehistoric camp site is situated on a high terrace from which Mato Tipila is visible to the east.

I urge you to deny this application to keep these important cultural resources undisturbed. Thank you.
