SUBJECT: RESPONSE TO REQUEST FOR REVISION TO REGULATORY GUIDES,
NUREG-0800, AND 10 CFR 50.55A THAT REFERENCE ASME NUCLEAR
CODES AND STANDARDS

Dear Mr. Hill:

In your letter of July 21, 2014, (NRC's Agencywide Documents Access Accession (ADAMS) No. ML14204A081), on behalf of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers, you requested that the NRC revise several NRC Regulatory Guides; NUREG-0800, "Standard Review Plan for the Review of Safety Analysis Reports for Nuclear Power Plants: LWR Edition;" and 10 CFR 50.55a, "Codes and Standards." This letter provides our response to that request.

Enclosed is a summary of the status of NRC reviews and revisions for the affected documents, as well as our plans for revising individual guidance documents.

Your request to revise 10 CFR 50.55a was initially treated as a petition for rulemaking. The NRC denied the petition in a separate letter dated October 10, 2014 (ADAMS Accession No. ML14233A112). Nonetheless, I am providing the information in the enclosure to inform you of the staff's plans to update its rules and regulatory guidance.

Please note that the NRC performs a periodic review of its regulatory guides every five years and posts the results and its plans for updating the guides on its public website under the regulatory guides document collection at: <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/reg-guides/#guides>.
