Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Region VI, the State of Louisiana and Waterford 3 Steam Electric Station request your support in the planning and execution of a Recovery Workshop in conjunction with the Waterford 3 Ingestion Phase Exercise in December of 2017.

The purpose of this workshop is to provide a forum for state, local, utility and federal partners to discuss and plan for long-term recovery following a radiological release from a nuclear power plant. This workshop will present the opportunity for all participants to discuss and identify planning and response activities beyond those typically associated with a plume or ingestion exercise.

Planning of this workshop will require input from private organizations and agencies at all levels of government. An initial planning call was conducted on February 26, 2016. Another planning call will be scheduled in April 19, 2016 at 1:30pm CST. Your assistance is needed to assure appropriate participation in the ingestion exercise and recovery workshop and to assist the Offsite Response Organizations in the development and review of their response plans and procedures.
