Sir:

With reference to Strata Energy's license application, i urge the NRC to consider that the proposed uranium mining and processing area has over 5000 abandoned drill holes from early days of U exploration. The expansion project may compromise old wells that might serve as conduits for water contamination. The NRC needs to analyze the risk that such old drillholes represent. As well, it needs to consider that the proposed mining and processing process has an extremely high consumptive use of water which might potentially draw down and contaminate the aquifers presently used for human and livestock drinking water, and the track record of so-called "spills."

Strata should not be allowed to expand until Powder River Basin REsource Council's appeal for the Ross Project is settled.
