



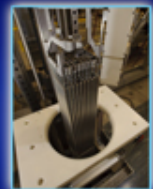

Mission

(“What We Do”)

The NRC licenses and regulates the nation's civilian use of radioactive materials to protect public health and safety, promote the common defense and security, and protect the environment.

LPR Process

(Purpose of the LPR)

- **Inform AREVA and the public of the results of the LPR, and**
- **Provide basis for adjusting the focus of inspections at AREVA.**

Use of Webinar

AREVA Current LPR (Results)

- **AREVA continues to conduct licensed activities safely and securely; protecting public health and the environment.**
- **AREVA has maintained its satisfactory performance. No areas needing improvement were identified.**
