# Revision Objectives

- Update, simplify, and consolidate guidance
- Focus on planning standards and evaluation criteria
- Maintain onsite/offsite emergency planning linkage
- Clarify document usage for each group of end users
- Have no impact on previous reasonable assurance findings
- Need only limited rulemaking to support revision

- Joint agency task force and writing teams
- Stakeholder input on process and scope
- Additional guidance development and updating
  - FEMA REP Program Manual
  - NRC Regulatory Guide 1.101



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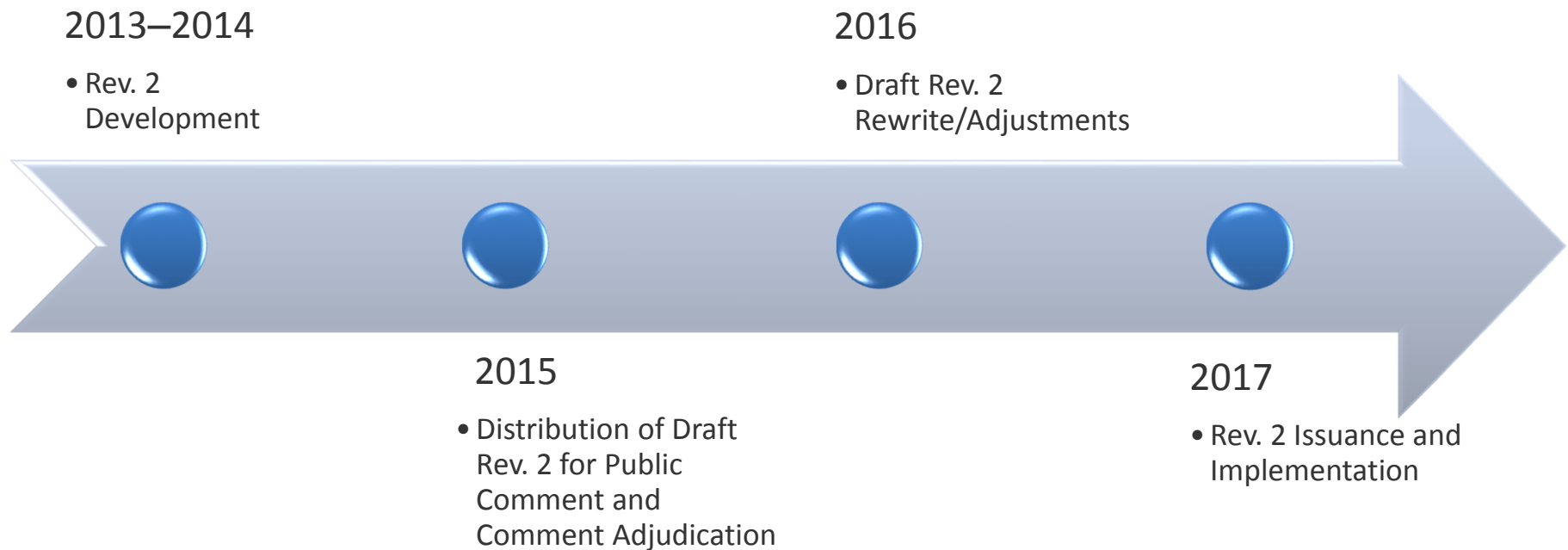
# Stakeholder Engagement

- August/September 2012: Scope and process sessions
- October 2013: Writing team work product review sessions
- June 2014: Follow-up document review session
- May/October 2015: Public comment period
  - 29 Submitters / 609 Comments
  - Comment focus areas
    - Licensee Table B-1 staffing levels and augmentation timeframes
    - Use of Joint Information System with Joint Information Center
    - Planning Standard N drills and exercises

- March 2016: Draft document update
- April 2016: NRC/FEMA EP staff review
- May 2016+: Final vetting NRC, FEMA, DHS, ACRS, OMB
- January 2017+: Document issuance, rollout, implementation
