
This letter is to acknowledge receipt of your application for renewal of the North Carolina Radioactive Materials License identified above. Your application has been deemed timely filed, and accordingly, the license will not expire until final action has been taken by this agency provided you furnish timely responses to any questions this agency may ask regarding your renewal application.

Any correspondence regarding the renewal application should reference your license number.

Effective as of February 1, 2015, the Radiation Protection Section's regulations previously in the Code under Title 15A, Environment and Natural Resources were changed to Title 10A, Health and Human Services. Rule extension numbers will not be changed and anywhere that 15A NCAC 11 is written will now be read as 10A NCAC 15. Any future correspondence with the Agency should reference 10A NCAC 15. As soon as the updated 10A NCAC 15 rules are made available they will be posted on www.ncradiation.net. Continue to reference the old state regulations and guidance documents under 15A NCAC 11 until they are properly updated as 10A NCAC 15. Please allow patience to the Section in updating State forms, web sites, policy statements and issued licenses.

Please note, that the North Carolina Radiation Protection Section (RPS) in step with the US Nuclear Regulatory Commission has recently adopted a new Safety Culture Policy Statement. While a policy statement and not a regulation, it sets forth the agency's expectations for individuals and organizations to establish and maintain a positive safety culture. You can access the policy statement and supporting material that may benefit your organization on the RPS website (<http://www.ncradiation.net>) and at <http://www.ncradiation.net/SAFETYCULTURE.pdf>. We strongly encourage you to review this material and adapt it to your particular needs in order to develop and maintain a positive safety culture as you engage in RPS regulated activities.
