Dear Mr. Hunt,

I have reviewed your letter dated April 13, 2016, concerning a change of address for your facility. Further information is necessary so that we may complete our review of your license amendment request.

In your letter, you indicated that you have received an amended possession license from the State of California that authorizes the transfer of your activities to the new location. Please provide a copy of your amended State of California possession license.

The requirements that apply to the submittal of such information are provided in 10 CFR 30.6. Recently, the NRC has been having difficulties receiving mail at its official address; therefore, I suggest that you send me a scan of your license to me via email.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. If we do not receive a reply from you within 30 calendar days from the date of this email, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your license amendment application.

Please be aware that upon your request, proprietary information submitted to the NRC may be withheld from public disclosure. To do this, you must follow the procedures in 10 CFR 2.390(b) including requesting withholding at the time the information is submitted and complying with the document marking and affidavit requirements set forth in 10 CFR 2.390(b)(1).

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, "Public inspections, exemptions, requests for withholding," a copy of this email will be available electronically for public inspection in NRC's Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records component of NRC's document system (ADAMS).
