Dear Mr. Bastian:

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) did not receive from Xcell Engineering, LLC, a timely renewal application for NRC License Number 11-29226-01, which had an expiration date of March 31, 2016. In letter dated May 2, 2016, you stated that your company incorrectly thought that by paying annual fees to the NRC that License Number 11-29226-01 would be renewed automatically. Xcell Engineering, LLC, upon being notified by the NRC of this non-compliance, immediately submitted a new license application on May 2, 2016, following the licensing guidance described in NUREG-1556, Volume 1, Revision 1. NRC issued a new license to Xcell Engineering, LLC, on May 2, 2016, and NRC License Number 11-29226-01 is hereby being retired.
