Dear Mr. Schouman,

I've reviewed your exempt distribution report that was attached to your email dated May 9, 2016, for the 2015 reporting period. You must revise your report so that it meets the reporting requirements for your license.

In the revision of your report, please address the following issues:

- Include your license number on the report as required by 10 CFR 40.53(c)(2).
- As required by 10 CFR 40.53(c)(2), include this or a similar statement in your report: "The products were transferred for use under 10 CFR 40.13(c)(7)."
- You have reported, for each part number, the amount of ThF₄ per unit and the total quantity of ThF₄ distributed. The reporting requirements for your license refer to the amount of thorium transferred and not the amount of ThF₄. Specifically, you are required by 10 CFR 40.53(c)(3)(ii) to report the total amount of thorium that was distributed in each product according to the part number. Please indicate the total amount of thorium transferred in each product according to the part number rather than ThF₄.

Further information about the requirements that apply to annual reports of exempt distribution can be found in the attached Regulatory Issue Summary.
