the reduction of administration of GFES exams to twice a year will result in utilities all scheduling their license exams in the same time frame, as all programs run approximately the same amount of time. With reduced staff, the regions will not be able to support the utilities exam needs.

Possible solutions

- allowing utilities to randomly generate a GFES exam as needed. The bank is sufficiently large to support this.
- develop an on-line exam. Give utilities a log in and have the candidates take a randomly generated exam that is generated at log in. A utility rep logs in with the license numbers for the individuals taking the exam. Once all are logged in, a randomly generated test could be taken on line. This would allow utilities to give the test at any time. If generated when the candidates logged in, it would be unique for those individuals and there would not be a compromise issue. At the end of the allowed time period, the exam closes and results sent to the utility contact.
