Ladies and Gentlemen:


On January 6, 2016 the NRC published a final rule amending the Holtec HI-STORM 100 Certificate of Compliance (CoC) No. 1014 as Amendment 9 Revision 1 (9R1) which became effective on March 21, 2016 and must be implemented by September 17, 2016. Condition 13 of CoC 9R1 required general licensees to perform written evaluations in accordance with 10CFR72.212 to apply the changes authorized by the revised certificate to previously loaded casks and then to re-register the casks within 30 days.

Southern Nuclear Operating Company (SNC) operates the Edwin I. Hatch Nuclear Plant (Hatch) Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI) in accordance with the general license provisions of 10 CFR 72.210 and performs dry storage activities under CoC 1014. On April 13, 2016, SNC completed a revision to the Edwin I. Hatch Nuclear Plant (Hatch) 10 CFR 72.212 report which applied the changes authorized by the revised certificate. Accordingly, SNC is providing the following registration information for casks loaded previously under CoC 1014 Amendment 9:
