On April 21, 2016, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) performed an Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI) security inspection at the Connecticut Yankee Atomic Power Company in East Hampton, Connecticut. The inspection covered the October 16, 2002, Interim Compensatory Measures for Dry Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installations Order and was conducted using NRC Inspection Procedure 81311, "Physical Security Requirements for Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installations", and Temporary Instruction (TI) 2800/041 "Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* Part 37 Materials Security Review – at Facilities with a Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations Part 73 Physical Protection Program."

The enclosed inspection report documents the inspection results, which were discussed with you, on April 21, 2016.

The inspection examined activities conducted under your license as they relate to security and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspector reviewed selected procedures and records, observed activities, and interviewed personnel.

Based on the results of this inspection, no findings were identified.

In accordance with Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR) 2.390, "Public Inspections, Exemptions, Requests for Withholding," of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC's Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS).
