SUBJECT: DISCONTINUATION OF THE EVALUATION OF TECHCOMP USA, DBA SCION  
INSTRUMENTS AMENDMENT REQUEST FOR SEALED SOURCE AND  
DEVICE REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE AND EXEMPT DISTRIBUTION  
LICENSE

Dear Mr. Cruz-Aedo:

This letter is in regards to your request dated November 11, 2015, requesting to amend Sealed Source and Device (SSD) Registration Certificate NR-1385-D-101-E and Exempt Distribution License (E-License) No. 04-35093-01E. After reviewing your application, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff sent you a letter dated February 11, 2016, requesting additional information (RAI) within 30 days. In an e-mail dated March 9, 2016, Mr. Sean Chapel requested an extension to submit a response on or before April 11, 2016, which was granted. On April 8, 2016, Mr. Chapel requested a second extension, which was not granted. On April 11, 2016, staff received the response to NRC RAI dated February 11, 2016. Staff reviewed the information and found deficiencies. On May 3, 2016, staff sent a second RAI requesting a response within 15 days. A response to the second RAI was not received by the requested date.

Due to the incomplete information, the NRC staff is unable to complete a safety evaluation of your SSD device and E-license amendment request, since Techcomp USA, DBA Scion Instruments did not respond to the NRC's RAI sent via e-mail on May 3, 2016. This action is taken without prejudice to re-submission of your amendment request. Please note, when you decide to re-submit the amendment request, ensure that you submit a complete amendment request with the necessary information to allow NRC to evaluate the changes.

Please be aware that upon your request, proprietary information submitted to the NRC may be withheld from public disclosure. To do this, you must follow the procedures in Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) 2.390(b), including requesting withholding at the time the information is submitted and complying with the document marking and affidavit requirements set forth in 10 CFR 2.390 (b)(1).

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Agency Rules of Practice and Procedure," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records component of NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS).
