NRC STAFF MOTION TO EXTEND THE DISCOVERY PERIOD

Discovery in the subject proceeding closes on April 23, 1998, under the Licensing Board's Order of March 19, 1998. The Staff Moves the Licensing Board to extend the period for discovery to and including Tuesday, May 12, 1998 for the following reasons:

1. Counsel for their parties had agreed to conduct depositions of the persons they felt necessary to the proceeding during the week of March 23, 1998 at the NRC's Regional office in Lisle, Illinois. On Friday, March 20, 1998, the Staff was informed that counsel for Conam Inspection, Inc. (Conam) had been involved in an accident and would not be able to either attend or conduct depositions during the week of March 23. Therefore, the Staff canceled the depositions it had noticed.

2. The Staff has made every reasonable effort to reschedule its depositions, and to provide its employees for deposition by Conam, to suit the convenience of Conam's counsel. Staff's efforts have thus far been fruitless. It is clear as of the date of this motion that discovery cannot be completed by April 23, 1998.

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
