Hi Tara – I hope all is well. Our training manager brought up some concerns regarding an INPO document being referenced in a draft regulatory guide.

The main concern is that Draft Regulatory Guide DG-5043 includes part of an INPO proprietary document on page 7 (see below). Also, Page 84 indicates that INPO documents are available on our public website (INPO normally does not make its documents public). Additionally, the document referenced, AP-921 (incorrectly typed as AP-21 on page 7) is no longer an active document – it was cancelled several years ago.

Please look into this and let me know your thoughts.
