By NRC Form 314, "Certificate of Disposition of Materials" dated April 22, 2016, you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and indicated that you wished to terminate NRC radioactive material license no. 13-32711-01. The NRC staff has reviewed the final status of the program. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from the facilities and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.

Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facility is suitable for unrestricted use and NRC license number no. 13-32711-01 is hereby terminated.
