Enclosed is an amendment application (PXB208.01) recently received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), dated May 3, 2016, from Halliburton Energy Services requesting the export to India of thorium-232 and Category 2 quantities of americium-241, americium-241/beryllium, and cesium-137, for the use in well logging and perforating operations.

Because India is a restricted destination as listed in 10 CFR 110.29, before taking action on this new request, we would appreciate your views, in accordance with established procedures and from the overall perspective of the Executive Branch, as to whether the requested export meets the applicable criteria in the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended.
