Transmittal of the PWROG Meeting Presentation Material Pertaining to the March 22, 2016 PWROG-NRC Meeting to Discuss the PWROG program PA-LSC-1366, "SSPS General Warning Alarm Modifications" that will develop and submit a topical report (TR) for NRC review and approval, PA-LSC-1336 R0

The Pressurized Water Reactor Owners Group (PWROG) met with the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff on March 22, 2016, in Rockville, Maryland, to discuss the PWROG program.

PWROG Program PA-LSC-1366, "SSPS General Warning Alarm Modifications" will develop and submit a topical report (TR) for NRC review and approval. The TR will provide the technical and licensing bases for a design change that modifies the solid state protection system (SSPS) general warning alarm (GWA) circuitry. Due to the discussion of Westinghouse proprietary information, this was a closed meeting.


