On December 18, 1998, Cabot Performance Materials (Licensee) filed an "Unopposed Motion for Additional Extension of Time to Respond To requests for a Hearing of (1) Redevelopment Authority of Reading and City of Reading and (2) Jobert Inc. and Metals Trucking, Inc." Licensee explained that the extension until April 1, 1999, which is subject to conditions set forth in the motion, is

to permit it to conduct further discussions with the Redevelopment Authority of Reading, the City of Reading, and Jobert Inc. (Jobert) and Metals Trucking, Inc. (MTI) to resolve their concerns about the Site Decommissioning Plan.
