In accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 50.54, "Conditions of licenses," paragraph (p)(2), LaCrosseSolutions, LLC (LS) is submitting changes to the La Crosse Boiling Water Reactor (LACBWR) Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI) Security Plan. LS is submitting these changes within 2 months of implementation.

LS has concluded that the changes do not decrease the safeguards effectiveness of the security plan.

The attachments contain safeguards Information. Therefore LS requests that this information be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, "Public inspections, exemptions, requests for withholding," paragraph (d)(1) and 10 CFR 73.21, "Protection of Safeguards Information: Performance Requirements," paragraph (a)(1)(i).
